

It is in Box 2

Solution is just process of elimination -

If it is in box 1, then the statements on Box 1 and 2 are true, invalidating the 1 true / 2 false condition.

If it is in box 3, then the statements on Box 2 and 3 are true, invalidating the 1 true / 2 false condition.

If it is in box 2, then only the statement on Box 3 is true, which does not invalidate the 1 true / 2 false condition.
